

Retrograde

Reversing the order of the movements or reversing a movement

Accumulation

Adding a movement into a motif but returning to the first movement. Example: A, AB, ABC, ABCD...

Embellishment

Detail is added to a move, such as a hand gesture or an arm movement

Canon

A movement **canon** occurs when **dancers** perform the same phrase one after the other

Unison

Performing all together

Repetition

A choreographic device whereby a movement or motif are repeated exactly for emphasis or to gain interest

Levels

The three **levels in dance** movement are high, middle and low.

Direction

Changing the way you are facing. For example, diagonal, back sides etc

Dynamics

Speed, weight and flow of movements.

Relationships
