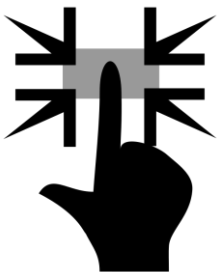
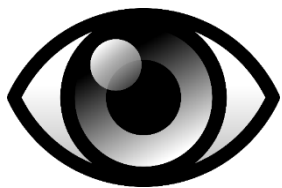


## Types of Stimulus:

## Theatre Roles:

Theatre role	Definition
Director	Person who comes up with the creative idea and gives notes (feedback) to actors.
Stage Manager	Someone who is in charge of rehearsals and all backstage elements.
Theatre Manager	Someone who looks after the audience, box office and health and safety of the venue.
Actor	Someone who performs to entertain the audience.



## Drama Techniques:

- Chorus (all talking at the same time, saying the same thing)
  - Freeze frame
  - Thoughts out loud
- Monologue (Speech performed on your own)
  - Split stage
  - Slow motion
- Flash back/ flash forward
