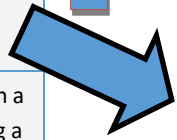


Film Music

Cuesheet	A detailed listing of musical cues matching the visual action of a film so that composers can time their music accurately to match the visual images.
Leitmotif	A short melodic theme within a film soundtrack, representing a particular object, idea or character in the story.
Soundtrack	The music and sound recorded on a film.
Storyboard	A planning tool (similar to a cuesheet) used by film soundtrack composers to plan the music to different scenes within a film.
Timing Clicks	A series of sounds which precede a musical soundtrack recording enabling editors to "sync" the musical soundtrack exactly with the video



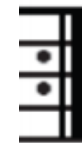

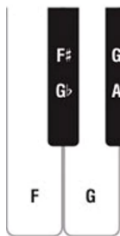

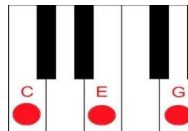
REPEAT MARKS – A musical symbol made up of two dots and two bar lines, indicating to the performer to go back to the beginning (or to the previous 'inverted' repeat marks) and perform the music again.



DISONANCE – Where the notes sound like they 'clash' together – often producing a 'tense' feel. You can create dissonance in using many different techniques. The easiest way is to play two notes a



CONSONANCE – Where the notes sound 'comfortable' or 'happy' with each other e.g. chord of C



CHORD – Two or more notes played at the same time.

BASS CLEF – A musical symbol indicating to performers to perform the notes at a certain (low) pitch

Line notes: E very G ood B oy D eserves F ootball (with a soccer ball icon)

Space notes: F A C E (with a smiley face icon)

Line notes: G reedy B ig D og's F all A sleep (with a dog icon)

Space notes: A I C ows E at G rass (with a cow icon)
