

Examination Performance Summary 2023

GCSE RESULTS 2023

We're delighted to announce another year of very successful GCSE examination results.

There has been a return to pre-pandemic grading this summer in England with protection in place for students. It is most meaningful to compare results to 2019, the last summer exam series before the pandemic.

Attainment 8 Score = 50.92 (National Average = 46.7 in 2019)

72% of students achieved the standard pass grade (4+) in both English and Maths.
50% of students achieved the strong pass grade (5+) in both English and Maths.
15% of students achieved grade 7,8 or 9 in both English and Maths.

88% of students achieved the standard pass grade (4+) in English
78% of students achieved the strong pass grade (5+) in English
28% of students achieved grade7,8 or 9 English

72% of students achieved the standard pass grade (4+) in Maths.51% of students achieved the strong pass grade (5+) in Maths.22% of students achieved grade 7, 8 or 9 in Maths.

25% of all GCSE grades were at grade 7, 8 or 9.

51% of students achieved the Ebacc set of subjects with standard pass (grade 4+) in Maths, English, Humanities, Languages and 2 or more Science qualifications.

30% of students achieved the Ebacc set of subjects with strong pass (grade 5+) in Maths, English, Humanities, Languages and 2 or more Science qualifications.

EBacc APS= 5.05 (91% of students were entered for the Ebacc set of subjects)
