

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A LEVELS (2 years)

ENTRY CRITERIA

Between 4 to 6 GCSE grade 6+ qualifications depending on the A Levels you choose.

For all A Level subjects there is a minimum entry requirement of English Language grade 6. Maths must be a minimum of grade 4 but often grade 5, 6 or 7 is required for some of the subjects. Check your chosen subjects below for specific entry criteria.

Five GCSE grade 4 qualifications including a grade 4 in English Language and/or grade 4 in Mathematics. You can resit one but not both.
